## DAVIDSON GRAVES AT TULLOCH



## Why is this Important?

The Last Three Generations of Davidsons of Tulloch are buried at this site. We believe future generations may say we have failed in our duty to look after a historic site if we do not pursue the current opportunities to secure a long term future for these graves.



The Location: The area was formerly known as "Millbank" is located just to the west of Tulloch Castle.

Today you can park in Chestnut Road and walk a few yards to the site. There is no formal path. The site today is quiet, secluded and slightly overgrown. The site is surrounded by broken fencing which can be readily repaired.

There has not been much vandalism but there has been years of neglect.

We believe the site can be made secure, the vegetation trimmed back, and the headstones cleaned and secured.

We believe that this site can be maintained at minimum annual cost and be of benefit to the history of the local community.

We believe there is support from the local community to protect this site.





## The Key Issues:

- This historic site is threatened by a proposed housing development which will surround the site. This development has been give "Outline Planning Permission".
- The CDA cannot stop this housing development but we can make efforts to protect and look after this historic site.
- This site is currently being offered to us for free except for legal costs.
- The CDA is investigating this offer. We are trying to determine and secure proper access.
